# Call 911



- Most important aspect of Greek life on The Hill is safety
- Good Samaritan Law - Call, Cooperate, Save Lives

***You will never  
get in trouble  
for calling 911!***

## Good Samaritan Law

Protects citizens from criminal charges if they call the police during emergencies, even if the situation involves broken laws such as the possession or consumption of illicit drugs.

Any person involved in a drug or alcohol overdose emergency that calls 911 for help is immune from arrest and prosecution for substance-related crimes. This rule applies to both the good Samaritan that dials 911 and the person suffering the overdose.

# Hazing

Any activity expected of someone joining a group (or to maintain full status in a group) that humiliates, degrades or risks emotional and/or physical harm, regardless of the person's willingness to participate
